FINANCIAL AID:

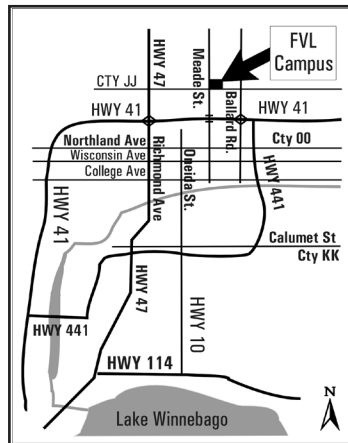
Financial assistance is provided through a variety of sources including area churches and the Tuition Assistance Program.

SCHOOL FACILITIES:

Chapel/auditorium with seating for 900, four computer labs, STEM lab, media center with writing lab, four science lab/lecture rooms, specialized labs for woodworking, visual arts, graphic arts and home-ec, cafeteria/commons, weight room/fitness center, two gymnasiums, lighted football field/all-weather track, soccer, baseball and softball fields, tennis courts, and 14-acre nature preserve.

BUSING:

Transportation to FVL is provided from 5 adjacent school districts within a 35-mile radius. A tuition rate reduction is provided for students outside busing service.
