#### **STEP 4:**

Package your entries and send the packet to FVL –

(You are welcome to send your entries with an FVL student from your school or church to save postage.)

- Teachers of multi-grade classrooms are welcome to have their whole class participate. You may send along the best posters from the other grades as well. Prize winners are only be chosen from the 4th grade entries, but we always reserve the right to give special awards for entries of younger students.
- All entries will be judged according to the enclosed **CONTEST GUIDELINES. Please stress to your students not to copy previous winners, and not to use trademarked images (such as Disney characters)! All entrants will receive a certificate of participation. All winners will receive prizes. The Grand Prize winning poster will be printed in full color and distributed to all Federation churches and schools next school year. A copy of last year's winner is enclosed for display in your classroom. Posters become the property of FVL for display and use in promotions. Posters will be judged this year during April and awards will be distributed in late April or early May.**
